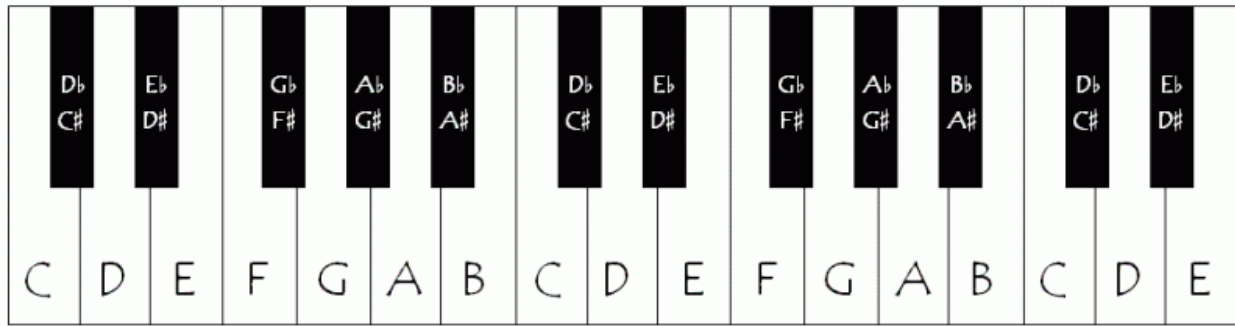

C Major Chord Review

| Initial (Root) | 1st Inversion | 2nd Inversion |
| C E G | E G C | G C E |

I-IV-V Chord Progressions

|--------------|--------------|--------------|
| 1 | 4 | 5 |
| C E G | C F A | D G B |

II-III-VI-VII Progressions

|--------------|--------------|--------------|--------------|
| 2 | 3 | 6 | 7 |
| D F A | E G C | A C F | B D G |
